1.0 INTRODUCTION

The contractor shall provide engineering, scientific, technical, and logistic and installation support services, including the engineering and technical support personnel and facilities, required to support In-Service Engineering and Life Cycle Management Support for the U.S. Navy Shipboard Environmental Systems Engineering Program at Naval Surface Warfare Center, Carderock Division (NSWCCD) Philadelphia. Shipboard environmental systems applicable to this solicitation include Oil Pollution Abatement (OPA) systems, Solid Waste Equipment (SWE), Non-oily Wastewater (NOW) (sewage and graywater) systems, and Shipboard Hazardous Material Control and Management (HMC&M) equipment. 3.0 TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS/SCOPE

3.1 IN-SERVICE ENGINEERING SUPPORT

The Contractor shall perform the following duties in support of the U.S. Navy Shipboard Environmental Systems Engineering Program In-Service Engineering efforts:

- 1) Investigate production and field deficiencies on Navy shipboard environmental equipment systems and components and support resolution via the NSWCCD.
- 2) Provide Fleet shipboard technical assistance including equipment installation, troubleshooting, repair, removal, and maintenance, as requested by NSWCCD. Provide follow-on training during ship visits to ship's force and debrief the appropriate Officer-In-Charge (OIC) and/or Non-Commissioned Officer-In-Charge (NCOIC) at the conclusion of each ship visit.

The contractor shall purchase all materials identified as contractor furnished and incidental material.

Provide temporary stowage for Government Furnished Material (GFM) as identified by the applicable installation documentation provided as Government Furnished Information (GFI). Shipping of GFM to installation site will be required.

- 3) Provide shore side equipment inspection and grooming services to ships as instructed by the Technical Point of Contact (TPOC).

- 4) Provide engineering support for environmental equipment systems and components design development, installation drawing development, and drawing review.

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5) Develop ILS for the shipboard environmental equipment systems and components as instructed by NSWCCD. ILS includes detailed technical manuals, design guidance, Allowance Parts Lists (APL), Allowance Equipage List (AEL), Planned Maintenance System (PMS), and operating procedures (EOSS or steam plant manual).

3.2 LIFE CYCLE MANAGEMENT SUPPORT

The Contractor shall perform the following duties in support of the U.S. Navy Shipboard Environmental Systems Engineering Program Life Cycle Management efforts:

1) Support the Equipment Design Review Teams (EDRT), participate in meetings and provide design input, design revision recommendations and development plans, and submit engineering change proposals for Government review, and maintain EDRT action logs and records of meeting minutes.

2) Write and recommend updates, as required, to technical manuals; installation drawings and procedures; inspection, grooming, and salvage criteria; ILS documentation for systems, equipment and components, serve as the drawing and document repository and maintain configuration control of all shipboard environmental systems equipment and components drawings, installation control drawings, integration manuals, technical manuals, and technical repair standards and any other documentation as required and mutually agreed between the contractor and the TPOC, including but not limited to the items listed in Section 2. This information and all updates shall be placed on a computer file server of which the Government has access. Develop integration requirements for shipboard environmental machinery. Review and make recommendations to Planned Maintenance System (PMS) Maintenance Requirement Cards (MRCs) for shipboard environmental systems.

3) Perform engineering design/analyses; failure analyses; systems integration; control systems programming and support including PLC; develop conceptual models, prototypes, and engineering drawings; and revise existing shipboard environmental equipment engineering drawings, technical documents, and 3-dimensional models as required resulting from design modifications and shipboard environmental equipment action items.

4) Perform manufacturability reviews, cost reviews, design tradeoffs studies, and market surveys to identify replacement or alternative parts. Perform design, manufacturing, material and dimensional assessment of the components and assemblies of the required design changes.

5) Prepare test plans, test reports, and perform data collection, statistical analyses, and interpretation for prototype systems and components. Perform equipment testing, test site and/or field/shipboard evaluations, and equipment/component validation. Procure test materials, and design, fabricate, and assemble applicable components/test fixtures/articles for testing and evaluation.

6) Perform design, manufacturing, material and dimensional assessment of prototypical and/or commercial-off-the-shelf (COTS) systems, equipment and components and support tests of those systems.

7) Assist with development of long range plans, schedules and alteration packages, and attend technical and programmatic meetings as required.

8) Provide manufacturing and quality assurance support for the fabrication of shipboard environmental equipment, and assessments of failed production equipment. Perform independent assessments of failed or problematic production equipment, and participate in vendor assessments, hardware inspections and field evaluations as required.

9) Perform Failure Modes, Effects, and Criticality Analysis (FMECA), Systems Safety Analysis (SSA), reliability analyses, shock, vibration, and Electromagnetic Interference (EMI) testing, and document and interpret the results of this testing, on shipboard environmental equipment, prototype systems, and/or COTS systems, as required.

10) Provide Navy Fleet operational experience to develop/design (under the guidance of NSWCCD) Standard Operating Procedures for shipboard environmental systems. Develop/design procedures and implementation

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guidance for the extension/integration of shore-side logistics management programs to Navy Ships, including analysis and validation of ship requirements to support operational and maintenance requirements.

11) Provide production/engineering services in support of shipboard environmental systems, consisting of developing/reviewing the design drawings and the engineering technical design specifications. Update (under the guidance of NSWCCD) Installation Guidelines for shipboard environmental systems. This effort shall include, as required, installations onboard CVN-78, LCS, DDX, and LHA(R) ship acquisition programs.

12) Develop performance specifications and technical purchase descriptions; perform data analysis; computer programming and software engineering. As directed by NSWCCD, develop web-enabled data management tools and systems for shipboard environmental systems. Develop functional specification requirements in support of shipboard environmental systems software programs, including interface with legacy and future programs. Provide software engineering to identify materials listed in PMS Maintenance Requirement Cards (MRCs).

13) Provide support in the development of Spill Contingency Plans. Support identification of emergent spill response equipment and the maintenance of existing Integrated Logistics Support (ILS) for current hazardous material and oil spill response kits.

14) Review training for current and future Navy shipboard environmental systems courses, including review of course curriculum and Computer Based Training (CBT) and Video Teletraining (VTT) formats.

15) Provide on-site technical Life Cycle Management support for shipboard environmental systems as required by NSWCCD.

(a) The Contractor agrees to provide the total level of effort specified in the next sentence in performance of the work described in Sections B and C of this contract. The total level of effort for the performance of this contract shall be 98080 total man-hours of direct labor, including subcontractor direct labor for those subcontractors specifically identified in the Contractor's proposal as having hours included in the proposed level of effort.

(b) Of the total man-hours of direct labor set forth above, it is estimated that 0 man-hours are uncompensated effort.

Uncompensated effort is defined as hours provided by personnel in excess of 40 hours per week without additional compensation for such excess work. All other effort is defined as compensated effort. If no effort is indicated in the first sentence of this paragraph, uncompensated effort performed by the Contractor shall not be counted in fulfillment of the level of effort obligations under this contract.

(c) Effort performed in fulfilling the total level of effort obligations specified above shall only include effort performed in direct support of this contract and shall not include time and effort expended on such things as (local travel to and from an employee's usual work location), uncompensated effort while on travel status, truncated lunch periods, work (actual or inferred) at an employee's residence or other non-work locations (except as provided in paragraph (j) below), or other time and effort which does not have a specific and direct contribution to the tasks described in Sections B and C.

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SECTION H SPECIAL CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

Option to Extend Services

The Government may require continued performance of any services within the limits and at the rates specified in the Task Order. The option provision may be exercised more than once, but the total extension of performance hereunder shall not exceed 6 months. The Contracting Officer may exercise the option by written notice to the Contractor within 10 days prior to Task Order end date.

(End of Clause)

Option to Extend the Term of the Task Order

(a) The Government may extend the term of this task order under option CLINs/SUBCLINs by written notice to the Contractor on or before 4 Apr 2009; provided, that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to exercise the option(s) at least thirty days before the task order expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.

(b) The total duration of this task order, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed five years.

CAR-H09 Performance-Based Acquisition Evaluation Procedures for a SeaPort e Task Order (MAR 2006) (NSWCCD)

(a) Introduction: The contractor's performance on this task order will be evaluated by the Government, in accordance with this task order clause. The first evaluation will cover the period ending twelve months after the date of task order award with successive evaluations being performed for each twelve-month period thereafter until the contractor completes performance under the task order. Based on the evaluation results, the PCO will assign an overall performance rating in accordance with paragraph (b) of this clause. The purpose of the evaluation is to determine remedies that may be invoked due to "Unsatisfactory" performance. If the PCO assigns an "Unsatisfactory" performance rating for the period evaluated, the PCO may take unilateral action, in accordance with clause 52.246-5 entitled "Inspection of Services-Cost Reimbursement", dated Apr 1984, in Section E of the base contract, to provide for a fee reduction covering the performance period evaluated. This clause provides the basis for evaluation of the contractor's performance and for determining if the fee amount should be reduced due to "Unsatisfactory" performance.

(b) Performance Ratings: The Government will evaluate the contractor's performance of the Statement of Work under the task order for each twelve month period of performance, using the measurable performance standards set forth in the Performance Requirements Summary Table in the SOW, or elsewhere in the task order, and the PCO will assign one of the following ratings:

- (1) Excellent
- (2) Very Good
- (3) Satisfactory
- (4) Unsatisfactory

The standards associated with these ratings are given in the following Table 1.

Table 1: Overall Performance Ratings

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For The Evaluation Period

Overall Performance Rating	Standard
Excellent	“Excellent” ratings for all performance evaluation criteria.
Very Good	A combination of “Excellent” and “Satisfactory” ratings determined by the PCO to exceed “Satisfactory” overall.
Satisfactory	A minimum of “Satisfactory” ratings for all performance evaluation criteria.
Unsatisfactory	A rating of “Unsatisfactory” for one or more performance evaluation criteria.

(c) Evaluation Objective: The purpose of the evaluation and the inclusion of a remedy to the Government for unsatisfactory contractor performance under this task order is to ensure that the Government receives at least “Satisfactory” overall performance.

(d) Performance Evaluation Criteria: The contractor’s performance will be evaluated on an annual basis using the criteria and standards provided for each task objective in the Performance Requirements Summary Table, and considering the criterion in Tables 2 through 4 of this task order clause.

(e) Organization: The performance evaluation organization consists of the Procuring Contracting Officer (PCO), who will serve as the Evaluation Official, and the Task Order Manager (ToM).

(1) ToM: The ToM will provide ongoing performance monitoring, evaluate task performance based on the task order Performance Requirements Summary, prepare the evaluation report, including a recommended overall performance rating, and submit the report to the PCO for final decision within thirty days after the end of the evaluation period. The ToM will maintain the written records of the contractor’s performance so that a fair and accurate evaluation is made.

(2) Procuring Contracting Officer (PCO): The PCO is responsible for properly administering the performance evaluation process, maintaining the official performance evaluation file, and making the decision about the overall performance rating and whether to reduce the fee if performance is rated as unsatisfactory.

(f) Evaluation Schedule: Each performance evaluation will cover the previous twelve months of performance. The Government will evaluate all work under the task order performed by the contractor during the twelve-month period. Following each evaluation period, the PCO (or Contract Specialist if so designated by the PCO) and the ToM will hold a meeting with the contractor’s Senior Technical Representative to review performance under the task order during the previous twelve months, including overall trends, specific problem areas, if any, and their resolution. Other Government and contractor personnel may also participate as deemed appropriate.

(g) Contractor’s Self-Evaluation: The contractor may also submit a Self-Evaluation Report for consideration. The report must include an overall performance rating for the task order, covering the evaluation period, and may include whatever information the contractor deems relevant to support that rating. The report shall not exceed two (2) pages in length.

(h) Performance Evaluation: The PCO will make the decision on the overall performance rating for the work performed under the task order within thirty days after receipt of the evaluation report from the ToM. The decision will be based upon the ToM’s recommendations, the contractor’s comments, including any Self-Evaluation Report, and any other information deemed relevant by the PCO. The PCO shall resolve disagreements between the ToM’s recommendations and the contractor’s comments/report regarding the evaluation. The PCO will provide a copy of the evaluation report, including the overall rating, to the contractor within five working days after completion of the evaluation.

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(i) Contractor’s Review of the Evaluation Report: Contractors shall be given a minimum of 15 calendar days to submit comments, rebut statements, or provide additional information. The PCO shall consider the contractor’s submission and respond as appropriate. Although the PCO will consider the contractor’s comments, rebuttals, or additional information, the PCO may, or may not, change the overall rating. The decision to change the rating based on contractor input at this stage is solely at the discretion of the PCO.

(j) This performance evaluation does not replace any other requirement for evaluating contractor performance that may be required by the base contract, such as a Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) report, or a Task Order Performance Evaluation (TOPE).

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SECTION I CONTRACT CLAUSES

52.222-2 PAYMENT FOR OVERTIME PREMIUMS (JUL 1990)

(a) The use of overtime is authorized under this contract if the overtime premium cost does not exceed \$0.00 or the overtime premium is paid for work --

(End of Clause)

As long as the overtime hours do not exceed the 1280 overtime hours identified in the "Level of Effort" Table in Section B.

CAR-I18 TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS (DEC 2001)

(a) Performance of the work hereunder may be subject to written technical instructions signed by the Task Order Manager. As used herein, technical instructions are defined to include the following:

(1) Directions to the Contractor that suggest pursuit of certain lines of inquiry, shift work emphasis, fill in details or otherwise serve to accomplish the statement of work.

(2) Guidelines to the Contractor that assist in the interpretation of drawings, specifications or technical portions of work description.

(b) Technical instructions must be within the general scope of work stated in the task order. Technical instructions may not be used to :

(1) assign additional work under the task order;

(2) direct a change as defined in the "Changes" clause of the base contract;

(3) increase or decrease the contract price or estimated amount (including fee), as applicable,

the level of effort, or the time required for task order performance; or

(4) change any of the terms, conditions or specifications of the task order.

(c) If, in the opinion of the Contractor, any technical instruction calls for effort outside the scope of the task order or is inconsistent with this requirement, the Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer in writing within ten (10) working days after the receipt of any such instruction. The Contractor shall not proceed with the work affected by the technical instruction unless and until the Contracting Officer notifies the Contractor that the technical instruction is within the scope of this task order.

(d) Nothing in the paragraph (c) of this clause shall be construed to excuse the Contractor from performing that portion of the task order statement of work which is not affected by the disputed technical instruction.

(End of Clause)

Privacy Act Notification (Apr 1984)

The Contractor will be required to design, develop, or operate a system of records on individuals, to accomplish an agency function subject to the Privacy Act of 1974, Public Law 93-579, December 31, 1974 ([5 U.S.C. 552a](#)) and

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applicable agency regulations. Violation of the Act may involve the imposition of criminal penalties.

(End of clause)

Privacy Act (Apr 1984)

(a) The Contractor agrees to—

(1) Comply with the Privacy Act of 1974 (the Act) and the agency rules and regulations issued under the Act in the design, development, or operation of any system of records on individuals to accomplish an agency function when the contract specifically identifies—

(i) The systems of records; and

(ii) The design, development, or operation work that the contractor is to perform;

(2) Include the Privacy Act notification contained in this contract in every solicitation and resulting subcontract and in every subcontract awarded without a solicitation, when the work statement in the proposed subcontract requires the redesign, development, or operation of a system of records on individuals that is subject to the Act; and

(3) Include this clause, including this paragraph (3), in all subcontracts awarded under this contract which requires the design, development, or operation of such a system of records.

(b) In the event of violations of the Act, a civil action may be brought against the agency involved when the violation concerns the design, development, or operation of a system of records on individuals to accomplish an agency function, and criminal penalties may be imposed upon the officers or employees of the agency when the violation concerns the operation of a system of records on individuals to accomplish an agency function. For purposes of the Act, when the contract is for the operation of a system of records on individuals to accomplish an agency function, the Contractor is considered to be an employee of the agency.

(c)(1) "Operation of a system of records," as used in this clause, means performance of any of the activities associated with maintaining the system of records, including the collection, use, and dissemination of records.

(2) "Record," as used in this clause, means any item, collection, or grouping of information about an individual that is maintained by an agency, including, but not limited to, education, financial transactions, medical history, and criminal or employment history and that contains the person's name, or the identifying number, symbol, or

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other identifying particular assigned to the individual, such as a fingerprint or voiceprint or a photograph.

(3) "System of records on individuals," as used in this clause, means a group of any records under the control of any agency from which information is retrieved by the name of the individual or by some identifying number, symbol, or other identifying particular assigned to the individual.

(End of clause)

DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION (DEC 1991)

(a) The Contractor shall not release to anyone outside the Contractor's organization any unclassified information, regardless of medium (e.g., film, tape, document), pertaining to any part of this contract or any program related to this contract, unless—

(1) The Contracting Officer has given prior written approval; or

(2) The information is otherwise in the public domain before the date of release.

(b) Requests for approval shall identify the specific information to be released, the medium to be used, and the purpose for the release. The Contractor shall submit its request to the Contracting Officer at least 45 days before the proposed date for release.

(c) The Contractor agrees to include a similar requirement in each subcontract under this contract. Subcontractors shall submit requests for authorization to release through the prime contractor to the Contracting Officer.

(End of clause)
