(c) The fee(s) specified in SECTION B, and payment thereof, is subject to adjustment pursuant to paragraph (g) of the special contract requirement entitled "LEVEL OF EFFORT." If the fee(s) is reduced and the reduced fee(s) is less than the sum of all fee payments made to the Contractor under this contract, the Contractor shall repay the excess amount to the Government. If the final adjusted fee exceeds all fee payments made to the contractor under this contract, the Contractor shall be paid the additional amount, subject to the availability of funds. In no event shall the Government be required to pay the Contractor any amount in excess of the funds obligated under this contract at the time of the discontinuance of work.

**1. NSWC CRANE VISITOR INFORMATION: PORTABLE ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY**

NSWC Crane has implemented full compliance with the NAVSEA Access and Movement Control Instruction 5510.2C, dated 7 August 2012, which restricts the use of portable electronic devices (PEDs) in all NAVSEA spaces. In accordance with NSWC Crane Policy Letter 14-02 dated 20 March 2014, all government civilian, military and contractor personnel assigned to NSWC Crane and all visitors are prohibited from bringing any device or equipment capable of recording, transmitting or exporting photographic images or audible information of any kind into NSWC Crane spaces. This policy prohibits all personal electronic devices other than personal cell phones. For the purpose of this policy, "spaces" include outdoor ranges and test areas. NSWC Crane areas will be clearly marked. Prohibited devices include: MP3 players, e-readers, digital recording devices, laptop and tablet computers, and/or other electronic devices not provided by the government or specifically authorized. One-way pagers are allowed for fire, safety and security purposes. These devices can be used in non-NSWC Crane areas.

**2. RAPIDGate NSA/NSWC CRANE INSTALLATION ACCESS**

NSA/NSWC Crane is implementing the Navy Commercial Access Control System (NCACS) projects. The NCACS is the standard identity management and perimeter installation access control solution for the access management of vendors, contractors, suppliers and service providers who are not authorized a Common Access Card (CAC). The rationale for implementation of this system is to increase security while reducing impacts to the contractor community by improving efficiencies for base entry.

A new protocol being implemented to fulfill this NCACS requirement is the RAPIDGate system. The system meets Presidential Directive (HSPD-12) requirements by providing background checks of contractor personnel. A personal badge that affords base access (and/or multiple base access) for one year will be issued to each Contractor employee that meets background check criteria. While Contractors are not required to participate in this program, those Contractors who choose not to participate will be required to obtain daily passes for base access.

For contracts which include the FAR 52.204-9 Personal Identity Verification of Contractor Personnel or will otherwise require frequent access to the Naval Support Activity (NSA)/NSWC Crane site, contractors should consider taking advantage of the benefits available from the RAPIDGate program. A Government Sponsor is required to validate a Contractor's request for RAPIDGate access, and shall be the Contracting Officer's Representative (COR). 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## SECTION C DESCRIPTIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

**1.0 SCOPE.** This Statement of Work (SOW) sets forth the requirements for non-personal professional, engineering, technical assessments and special studies, and management support services required by the Strategic Missions Systems Engineering Division (GXT), at NSWC Crane. Support is required for Model Based Systems Engineering (MBSE), Model Based Engineering (MBE), Engineering & System Integration, Test Engineering, Reliability Maintainability and Availability (RM&A) Engineering, Quality Assurance Engineering, System Engineering, Modeling and Simulation, Prototyping oversight, System design documentation, Interface Management, Configuration Management, Requirements Management, and Program Management.

The contractor performing this SOW shall provide these services to the Strategic Missions Systems Engineering Division (GXT) at NSWC Crane in support of the US Navy, Strategic Systems Program (SSP), US Special Operations Command (SOCOM), Missile Defense Agency (MDA), National Aeronautics Space Administration (NASA), Office of Undersecretary of Defense/Defense Standardization Program Office (OSD/DSPO), United States Air Force (USAF), US Army Space and Missile Defense Command (SMDC), and Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA), Naval Air Systems Command (NAVAIR), United States Marine Corps (USMC), Printed Circuit Board (PrCB) Executive Agent (EA), and Other Government Agencies (OGA). The contractor shall provide advanced engineering support pertaining to Strategic Systems Programs (SSP) sustainment and development programs, including the Strategic Weapons Systems (SWS) Shipyard Integrated Test Program (SITP), configuration management, and SWS technical interfaces via SSP Coordination processes. SWS SITP, Configuration Management and coordination processes will support SWS on OHIO and OHIO-Replacement Program (ORP), conventional attack programs (SSGN and advanced hypersonic technology demonstrations), TRIDENT Missile Program, TRIDENT MK6LE and D5LE Programs, the SSP Life Extension Electronic Parts Program (LEEPP), SWS Ashore & Aegis Ashore Programs directly involving SITP, and OGA's conducting advanced hypersonic technology demonstrations and analysis.

This tasking requires managers, engineers, and technicians with extensive hands on experience in operations of the SWS on board OHIO Class Ballistic Missile Submarines (SSBNs), at SWS Facilities in the United States, and the United Kingdom for the TRIDENT II D5 SWS. Additional subsystems include SP23 (Fire Control) and SP22 (Guidance), SP24 (Navigation) and SP27 (Missile).

The contractor shall support the planning and execution of the SITP to verify installation, operation, and performance of the SWS. The SITP is the means by which the SWS equipment installation, operation, and performance is verified to SSP and the Chief Strategic Systems Executive (CSSE) for each US and UK SSBN platform. The SWS, having technical performance requirements, as defined in SWS Technical Objectives and Guidelines (TOG), will be tested in accordance with processes specified in SSP and NAVSEA documentation. The SWS consists of the following flight subsystems: Missile, Guidance, and Reentry. The SWS also includes the following shipboard subsystems: Navigation, Fire Control, Launcher, Missile Test, Instrumentation, Shipboard Data System (SDS), and Ship Support.

**1.1 Background.** GXT provides onsite systems integration technical support and engineering design and life cycle support for SSP, SOCOM, and OGA's. For SSP's Systems Integration and Compatibility Branch (SP2012), GXT Division supports the SITP and systems requirements for definition of interfaces via the coordination process. GXT provides support to the Department of



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Defense (DoD) Research and Development (R&D) efforts to study advanced hypersonic technologies. Current efforts are focused on material and technology development through various test programs. SSP is currently leading the Navy's effort for hypersonic technology development, and multiple OGA's support various aspects of the technology development efforts.

GXT provides ongoing support to Navy SSP for the SSGN Program, OHIO Class, Ohio ORP SWS, MDA Ground Based Interceptor (GBI) program, as well as provide the requisite expertise to provide advanced technology demonstration, analysis, and engineering support for hypersonic technologies. **3.0 Requirements.** Work to be performed, required data deliverables, and applicable governing documents will be specifically described in TIs to be placed against this TO and will be within scope of one or more of the task requirements in the following paragraphs. Contractor shall furnish labor, facilities, material, travel, and equipment necessary for the task. Contractor will provide personnel located at a contractor site within 10 miles of SSP Headquarters/Pentagon, and also on contractor site within 50 miles of NSWC Crane. Additional TDY work locations at remote sites, e.g. Cape Canaveral, FL, Groton, CT, and Barrow-in-Furness, United Kingdom (UK) will be defined in Technical Instructions (TIs). The Government may, as necessary, provide material, facilities, and equipment as Government Furnished Information (GFI), Government Furnished Material (GFM), Government Furnished Facilities (GFF), and Government Furnished Equipment (GFE), which will be specified in each TI. The contractor shall have plans and procedures in place to manage GFM In Accordance With (IAW) applicable laws and regulations.

Processes and technical information, based on specific Naval and SWS experience for strategic nuclear weapons, SSBN, weapons facility operations, nuclear safety and security, TRIDENT testing requirements, SWS shipyard integration and test, logistics, delivery, strategic missile and ordnance handling are required to be developed. Functional areas to be supported under this TO are described in the sections below.

Numbered subparagraph 3.1 - 3.22 that follow include language describing the support services that may be required under this order. Notwithstanding any language that may be capable of being interpreted differently, none of the support services shall be employed in a manner requiring the contractor to perform work of a policy/decision making or management nature, i.e., inherently Governmental functions. All decisions relative to programs supported by the contractor shall be the sole responsibility of the Government.

**3.1 Research and Development (R&D) Support.** Contractor shall provide R&D Engineering support consisting of development, design, modification of existing designs, model-based design (MBD), and validation testing/design of systems to perform validation testing. Contractor shall assist in the preparation of technical data, analytical reports, technical presentations, configuration product baselines, and establish sustainment systems associated with new technologies being developed to achieve the fielding of a relevant, effective, and sustainable shore based SWS. The contractor shall provide advanced technical expertise to support R&D engineering by providing recommendations to the Government in R&D efforts in the areas of aerospace engineering, thermal protection systems, flight telemetry, material science, and hypersonic aerodynamics.

**3.2 Engineering, System Engineering and Process Engineering Support.** The contractor shall support development of new technologies and the necessary technical processes and plans to evaluate technology applications with new and/or existing delivery systems or platforms.

**3.2.1 Engineering Support.** The contractor shall provide engineering/technical support to

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GXT's mission consisting of development, design, demonstration, and test of materials, components, subsystems and associated systems. To support SITP, the contractor shall provide engineering support to GXT Division and SP2012 to develop the Shipyard Manning Standard for US and UK shipyards. The contractor shall support SITP test execution roles and responsibilities in US and UK shipyards.

**3.2.2 System Engineering Support.** The contractor shall provide systems engineering, advanced system engineering, systems integration engineering support for GXT. The contractor shall manage the definition and update and monitor maintenance of SWS technical requirements. The contractor shall conduct requirements change meetings in order to update the Test Document Group (TDG) program plans, schedules, and test planning documentation. The contractor shall perform requirements analysis to verify requirements meet technical plans, document deviations, and collect Objective Quality Evidence (OQE) to ensure compliance with those system requirements. The contractor shall provide system level analysis for the SITP. The system engineering analysis shall support the development of the SSP Tolerance Document. The contractor shall develop and sustain an advanced Risk Management Plan (RMP). The contractor shall provide advanced systems engineering analysis and management support to analyze and manage components and coordinated interfaces between all SWS subsystems, Strategic Weapon Support System (SWSS) and submarine support systems. The contractor shall provide systems integration with facility project planning to include engineering and technical assessment of the weapons systems, subsystems and components. This includes concept design development and definition, demonstration, validation and testing, engineering processes, and life cycle assessment for the SWS subsystems.

**3.2.3 Process Engineering Support.** The contractor shall provide process engineering support for the development and refinement of NSWC Crane, SSP, SOCOM, MDA, USAF, and SMDC systems engineering processes. Processes include: Risk Management, Configuration and Data Management Deviation, Technical and Programmatic Reviews, Requirements Management, Interface Management, Quality Assurance, Safety Engineering Management, and Reliability, Availability, and Maintainability (RAM). The contractor shall provide engineering support to the SSP Design Review Process, including System Requirements Review (SRR), Preliminary Design Review (PDR), Critical Design Review (CDR), Test Readiness Review (TRR), and Production Readiness Review (PRR). The contractor shall liaise between the SITP and the SWS Ashore Program. These processes will be based on new design activities, material restrictions, environmental impact, and United States (US) regulatory constraints.

**3.3 Modeling, Simulation, Stimulation, and Analysis Support.** The contractor shall provide integration and validation support of Mechanical, Electrical, Protocol, and Algorithm Modeling being developed by NSWC Crane. The contractor shall apply a standardized, rigorous, structured methodology to create and validate models and 3-D representations of designs and arrangements for systems and subsystems. The contractor shall support Model Based Engineering (MBE) processes to support all phases of engineering processes, from requirements definition, analysis, design, implementation, and verification, through deployment. The contractor shall use advanced modeling and simulation expertise to evaluate hypersonic technologies against multiple threat scenarios. The contractor shall utilize system lethality and operational modeling & simulation to evaluate operational effectiveness of weapon system effects, and command and control, in contested environments.

**3.4 Support for Prototyping, Pre-Production, Model-Making, and Fabrication Support.** The contractor shall provide support services for digital modeling, scaled prototyping, 3D model-making, and fabrication efforts to achieve the objectives identified by the associated

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organizations and ordering offices.

**3.5 System Design Documentation and Technical Data Support.** The contractor shall provide support of technical writing and program analysis for the development and update of strategic systems technical documentation. The contractor shall utilize engineering expertise to support hypersonic technology design documentation and technical data package development required to assure the detailed technical data documentation necessary to support system development reflects the latest design, configuration, integration, and installation concepts.

**3.5.1 Test Documentation.** The contractor shall provide program test documentation services to establish the SITP program Ordinance Documents (ODs) and SSP Instructions (SSPINSTs), including the test program strategy, test requirements outlines, test procedures, a test procedure index and shipyard Roles and Responsibilities (R/R) documents which define test strategy, requirements, authoring, reporting, and performance responsibilities. The contractor shall assist in developing the program requirements for the ORP New Construction Equipment Installation Procedures. The contractor shall provide engineering support to the Test Document Group (TDG) and the SSP Integrated Test Working Group and provide all necessary test documentation support.

**3.5.2 Computer Aided Design (CAD) Documentation.** The contractor shall use CAD tools to support design documentation support. The contractor shall provide support for system level 3D CAD and electrical CAD (eCAD) requirements and interface requirements models and artifacts. The contractor shall manage coordinated interfaces between all SWS subsystems, support equipment, SWSS and Missile Control Center Module (MCCM).

**3.5.3 Technical Data Support.** The contractor shall support technical writing and program analysis for the development and update of required technical data. The contractor shall review existing Technical Data Packages (TDP) – provided by other contractors – for technical accuracy, prepare changes for incorporation to the data package, make recommendations for changes with supporting rationale, and incorporate changes upon Government approval. The contractor shall support the development and review of technical manuals and test procedures.

**3.6 Software Engineering, Development, Programming, and Network Support.** The contractor shall provide support for specialized computer systems for system, subsystem and component models. The contractor shall provide support of data systems for maintaining and sharing program documentation.

**3.7 Reliability, Maintainability, and Availability (RM&A) Support.** The contractor shall provide support for RM&A in the areas of engineering analyses and technical assessments. This functional area consists of applying engineering, scientific, and analytical disciplines to ensure that systems and platforms RM&A requirements are integrated with the system design, development, and life cycle sustainment. Specific areas of knowledge needed to support RM&A tasking include recommendations for: RM&A program planning and development; support for requirements definition and review; design evaluation; reliability block diagram modeling; reliability prediction using MIL-HDBK-217, 217 Plus, Telcordia SR-332, and NSWC Standard 98; Failure Mode and Effects Analysis; Fault Tree Analysis; derating; test planning and evaluation; data analysis; reliability growth planning and analysis; supportability and sparing analysis; RM&A performance trending; Failure Reporting and Corrective Action System (FRACAS); editing RM&A proposal reviews, and RM&A's effect on readiness, system safety, mission success, total ownership cost, and logistics. The contractor shall have the ability to utilize software tools to assist with RM&A engineering tasks including PTC Windchill Quality Solutions and ReliaSoft. Access to Windchill Quality Solutions and ReliaSoft will be provided

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by the Government as GFI.

**3.8 Human Factors, Performance, and Usability Engineering Support.** The contractor shall provide effective Human Systems Integration (HSI) engineering principles to products developed, produced or maintained on which NSWC Crane is designated as the Design Agent. These disciplines shall be applied to ensure that design of interactive systems are safer, more secure, and easier to use thereby reducing accidents due to human error, increasing system integrity, and enabling more efficient operations. The contractor shall assure operators, maintainers, and support personnel with the required skills and knowledge are identified early in the system design phase.

**3.9 System Safety Engineering Support.** The contractor shall provide qualified personnel to support NSWC Crane in the performance of system safety engineering in order to ensure a safe environment is maintained throughout the product life cycle. The contractor shall support the development of processes and technical information associated with strategic nuclear weapons, SSBN, weapons facility operations, nuclear safety and security, TRIDENT testing requirements, shipyard operations, logistics and delivery, strategic missile and ordnance handling.

**3.10 Configuration Management (CM) Support.** The contractor shall provide configuration management support for projects under NSWC Crane in the areas of configuration planning, identification, control, accounting, and audits. **3.14 Interoperability, Test and Evaluation, Trials Support.** The contractor shall provide support of interoperability test development and conduct test and evaluation, and trials in order to achieve assurance that systems and its subsystems operate correctly with all interfacing systems and subsystems. The contractor shall support preparation of Program Test Documentation to establish the SITP documentation, which defines test strategy, requirements, test authoring, reporting and performance responsibilities. The contractor shall support the SP Alteration (SPALT) program to support design proofing, subsystem testing, interface testing, system testing, and equipment fault analysis.

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**3.15 Measurement Facilities, Range, and Instrumentation Support.** The contractor shall support SWS, weapons facility operations, testing requirements, and ordnance handling.

**3.15.1 Hardware, Software, Launcher and Flight Test Engineering Support.** The contractor shall support program test engineering efforts, including engineering analysis and planning for launch testing, flight test parameters, telemetry analysis and reporting, thermal systems analysis, data collection, frequency management, and multi-organization coordination for component, sub-system and system launch and flight tests.

**3.16 Logistics Support.** The contractor shall provide integrated logistics support (ILS), with guidance from ASD-STD S3000L – Logistic Support Analysis, ASD-SPEC S2000M International Specification for Material Management and MIL-PRF-49506, Logistic Management Information (LMI). The contractor shall assist in the development and update of ILS documentation. The contractor shall review existing, developed, or Government provided ILS documentation, identify problem areas, and provide recommended revisions to documentation relating to management and/or technical issues. The contractor shall prepare presentations and presentation materials on the status of ILS for use by the Government at these meetings. The contractor shall document the proceedings, and complete action items and assignments resulting from these meetings.

**3.16.1 - Interim Logistics Support.** The contractor shall support the receipt, material handling, inventory management, and control of customer material items. The contractor shall maintain an information system to support the operations of the material management support tasking. Support shall include, contact with on-Center and off-Center personnel to identify shipping and verify shipping manifests, and perform physical inventory, handling, and coordination of all material transactions. Various types of material can/will be included in the overall mix of items and will require a variety of material handling techniques. The contractor shall provide personnel certified to operate forklifts and Government vehicles needed to transport materials.

**3.17 Supply and Provisioning Support.** N/A – Paragraph not applicable.

**3.18 Training Support.** The contractor shall provide training on MBSE, 3D Immersive evaluation Systems, and 3D Model databases. The contractor shall provide engineering and analytical discipline assistance to ensure that the Strategic Missions Systems Engineering Division and their technical support community are provided with adequate instruction including applied exercises, resulting in the attainment and retention of knowledge and skills regarding the platforms, systems and subsystems, operated and maintained. Training support can include development of training manuals, tools, simulators and testing practices, as well as educational materials.

**3.19 In-Service Engineering, Fleet Introduction, Installation and Checkout Support.** The contractor shall support field engineering applications, level of repair analyses, engineering support to new and upgrade installation processes, and engineering oversight and support to on-site alterations. The contractor shall support the planning and execution of the SITP to verify installation, operation and performance of the SWS. The SITP is the means by which the SWS equipment installation, operation, and performance is verified to SSP and the CSSE for each US and UK SSBN platform. The contractor shall support all portions of SITP program planning and execution in accordance with ORP, UKS, and SITP program documentation.

**3.20 Program Support.** The contractor shall provide engineering and technical support to GXT in assisting in establishing and maintaining sound, documented program management practices meeting program requirements while optimizing performance and minimizing costs, e.g.

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Metrology and Calibration Laboratory; METBENCH Cal Management System (MCMS). The contractor shall provide a single Point of Contact (POC) for all efforts related to the planning, organizing, budgeting, and direction of the execution of the tasking set forth in this SOW. The contractor shall support the preparation, maintenance, and review of a Program Management Plan (PMP), Risk Management Plan (RMP), Work Breakdown Structures (WBS), Integrated Master Schedules (IMS), execution schedules, cost and technical baselines, contract management plans (plans, schedules, and procurement documents).

**3.20.1 Meeting Support.** The contractor shall provide meeting space and meeting support necessary to host program level meetings of up to 50 attendees. Notwithstanding any language that may be capable of being interpreted differently, none of the support services shall be employed in a manner requiring the contractor to perform work of a policy/decision making or management nature, i.e., inherently Governmental functions. All decisions relative to programs supported by the contractor shall be the sole responsibility of the Government.

#### **4.0 GOVERNMENT FURNISHED ITEMS**

##### **4.1 Government Furnished Information (GFI).**

The Government will provide all applicable technical documentation and information to the contractor as GFI. This includes technical manuals, training materials and information, drawings, specifications, procedures, processes, and quality system documents required for the performance of engineering, logistics, and technical support. Additional GFI will be provided at the discretion of the Government.

##### **4.2 Government Furnished Material (GFM).**

GFM will be provided when the contractor has a requirement for special or specific Government material in the performance of specific tasking. GFM will be identified as required utilizing Scheduled Government Furnished Property (SGFP) Form.

##### **4.3 Government Furnished Equipment (GFE).**

Government Furnished Equipment (GFE) will be provided when the Contractor has a requirement for special or specific Government equipment in the performance of specific tasking. GFE will be identified as required utilizing Scheduled Government Furnished Property (SGFP) Form.

##### **4.4 Government Furnished Facilities (GFF).**

The Government will only provide Contractor personnel NMCI owned/Government owned



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equipment (personal computer/printer with appropriate software (i.e., Microsoft Office) and a work area (desk and use of telephone with long distance/voice mail capability) for those positions identified as being located at a Government location upon contract award and/or when directed by TI. This equipment/facilities shall only be utilized for official Government business.

#### **4.5 Government Owned Vehicles (GOV).**

The Government may provide contractor access and authorization to operate Government owned vehicles for the purpose of transporting materials and documents to and from buildings within the NSWC Crane confines, if authorized under the applicable TI. Government provided vehicles shall be used solely for the purposes as described in these SOW. All drivers must present proof of valid operator driver's license prior to operating a government vehicle. The contractor shall operate motor vehicles IAW NSWCCRANEINST 11240.1 or most recent instruction.

All contractor personnel operating Government vehicles, to include materials handling equipment, shall be licensed in IAW provisions set forth IAW NSWCCRANEINST 11240.1 or most recent instruction, except when a valid state driver's license shall be accepted as proper authority for operation of commercial/administrative (non-tactical) vehicles up to and including 10,000 pounds gross vehicle weight upon completion of training courses as called out in NSWCCRANEINST 11240.1 or most current instruction. The contractor shall ensure contractor personnel have in their possession a valid US Government Motor Vehicle Operator's Identification Card (SF 46) or valid state driver's license, as applicable, when operating vehicles and equipment. Employees possessing a valid Government license need not be re-licensed. The contractor shall report any accidents involving motor vehicles or any other equipment IAW NSWCCRANEINST 11240.1 or most recent instruction.

#### **5.0 Data Deliverables**

The contractor shall deliver any relevant technical and financial data, engineering drawings, reports, repaired hardware and research data ordered under the Task Order(s). All data deliverables prepared under this Task Order(s) shall be delivered as either a hardcopy or on electronic media or both as specified on each TI. The data items shall be delivered to the Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) or the designated Requiring Technical Activity(RTA) person identified on each TI.

Frequency: As Required. The Government shall provide notification of all required reports and associated due dates.

Medium: Electronic Form (either MS Word or Adobe PDF file format). Document shall be transmitted via email or accessible via the Internet.

Due Date: Contractor shall be notified of specific due dates as required by the TI.

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## 5.1 Contract Status Reporting (eCRAFT)

a) The Contractor agrees to upload the Contractor's Funds and Man-hour Expenditure Report in the Electronic Cost Reporting and Financial Tracking (eCRAFT) System and submit the Contract Status Report on the day and for the same timeframe the contractor submits an invoice into the Invoicing, Receipt, Acceptance, and Property Transfer (iRAPT) system (CDRL A011). Compliance with this requirement is a material requirement of this contract. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in contract termination.

b) The Contract Status Report indicates the progress of work and the status of the program and of all assigned tasks. It informs the Government of existing or potential problem areas.

c) The Contractor's Funds and Man-hour Expenditure Report reports contractor expenditures for labor, materials, travel, subcontractor usage, and other contract charges.

### **1) Access:**

### **2) Submission and Acceptance/Rejection:**

The contractor shall submit their reports on the same day and for the same timeframe the contractor submits an invoice in iRAPT. The amounts shall be the same. eCRAFT acceptance/rejection will be indicated by e-mail notification from eCRAFT.

d) In conjunction with the COR and Contracting Officer, the Contractor shall assign standard eCRAFT labor categories to each existing proposed and executed labor category on the Task Order/Contract. The entire catalog of standard labor categories can be found at these two websites –

e) It is anticipated that eCRAFT will be available 1 October 2017. The Contractor agrees to implement eCRAFT within 30 days of its becoming available for input. In addition the Contractor agrees to upload back data from 1 October 2017 if the system is not available on the planned implementation date.

f. CDRL A011, Contract Status Report is hereby added to Section "J" of the Task Order.

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## **6.0 Special Conditions**

### **6.1 Security**

Performance on this TO will require contractor employees to have access to classified information up to and including the TOP SECRET level. The Contractor shall appoint a Security Officer who shall (1) be responsible for all security aspects of the work performed under this TO, (2) assure compliance with all DOD and Service regulations regarding security and (3) assure compliance with any written instructions from the Security Officers of each Government facility. In the event that any individual tasking requires a higher level of clearance, a separate DD Form 254 will be prepared and issued. The Contractor may be required to have access to live data during the performance of this TO. Any records and data or information the Contractor may have access to may be highly sensitive and confidential. The Contractor must not divulge any information about files, data processing activities or functions, user ids or passwords or any other knowledge that may be gained to anyone not authorized to have access to such information. It is the Contractor's responsibility to ensure that all required employees have proper authority. All classified material shall be processed and protected in accordance with the provisions of this SOW and all required instructions and directives in effect concerning the processing of classified material. U.S. Citizenship is required for all positions.

### **6.2 Travel**

The contractor may be required to travel throughout the continental United States (CONUS) and to locations outside of CONUS (OCONUS). The contractor shall be required to obtain/maintain a valid passport. Trip duration will normally not exceed five working days plus the required transit time (integration efforts may be multiple weeks). When required to obtain access to a Government facility, ship, aircraft, or other duty station, the contractor shall initiate requests for Need to Know Certification and submit these requests to the COR for appropriate action. Travel must be in accordance with Joint Travel Regulations per DoD. All travel undertaken by the contractor for performance of tasking must have prior authorization by the Contracting Officer or the COR.

### **6.3 Control of Contractor Personnel**

The contractor shall comply with the requirements of NAVWPNSUPPCENINST 5510.1 and NAVWPNSUPPCENINST 5910.1. All persons engaged in work while on Government property shall be subject to search of their persons (no bodily search) and vehicles at any time by the Government, and shall report any known or suspected security violations to the NSWC Crane Security Department. Assignment, transfer, and reassignment of contractor personnel shall be at the discretion of the contractor. However, when the Government directs, the contractor shall remove from contract performance any person who endangers life, property, or national security through improper conduct. All contractor personnel engaged in work while on Government property shall be subject to the Standards of Conduct guidance. Prior to conducting work under this contract, the contractor shall provide a list of employees that will be working on site. The employee list shall contain full names, security clearance levels, social security numbers, job titles, and original birth certificates. This list shall be updated within forty eight hours after changes occur.

### **6.4 Identification Badges**

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The contractor shall be required to obtain identification badges from the Government for contractor personnel to be located on Government property. The identification badge shall be visible and worn above the waist at all times while employees are on NSWC Crane property unless the contractor is performing an operation in which displaying the badge presents a safety hazard (working over machinery or live electrical equipment/batteries). The contractor shall furnish all requested information required to facilitate issuance of identification badges and shall conform to applicable regulations concerning the use and possession of the badges. The contractor shall be responsible for ensuring that all identification badges issued to contractor employees are returned to the NSWC Crane Security Department within forty eight hours following the completion of the contract, relocation or termination of an employee issued an identification badge, and upon request by the Contracting Officer.

### **6.5 Accident Reporting**

The contractor shall maintain an accurate record of and shall report all accidents to the COR and/or the NSWC Crane Security Department as prescribed by OPNAVINST 5102.1D.

### **6.6 Certification, Training, and Licensing Requirements**

The contractor shall provide personnel with the certification, training, and licenses to perform the mission work. The following types of certification or training may be required to complete tasking: Forklift Operator and other load handling equipment (hoists, cranes, etc.). The contractor shall operate a forklift (and therefore must secure and maintain a forklift license in accordance with applicable directives) and need special training for respirator usage, hazardous materials management, and other safety guidance related to execution of the task.

### **6.7 Release of Information**

All technical data provided to the Contractor shall be protected from unauthorized release to the public. All other information relating to the items to be delivered and services to be performed under this TO may not be disclosed by any means without prior approval of the authorized representative of the Contracting Officer. Dissemination or public disclosure includes but is not limited to permitting access to such information by foreign nationals by any other person or entity or publication of technical or scientific papers or advertising or any other proposed public release. The

Contractor shall provide adequate physical protection to such information so as to preclude access by any person or entity not authorized such access.

### **6.8 Privacy Act**

Under US Code Title 5, Section 552, information accessed in completing this TO is subject to the Privacy Act.

### **6.9 Damage Reporting**

The Contractor shall maintain an accurate record of and shall report to the COR all damages to Government Furnished Equipment and Facilities as prescribed by OPNAVINST 5102.1.

### **6.10 Non-Personal Services**

The Government will neither supervise contractor employees nor control the method by which

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the contractor performs the required tasks. Under no circumstances will the Government assign tasks to, or prepare work schedules for, individual contractor employees. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to manage its employees and to guard against any actions that are of the nature of personal services, or give the perception of personal services. If the contractor feels that any actions constitute, or are perceived to constitute personal services, it shall be the contractor's responsibility to notify the TO COR and PCO immediately. These services shall not be used to perform work of a policy/decision making or management nature, i.e., inherently Governmental functions. All decisions relative to programs supported by the contractor shall be the sole responsibility of the Government.

## **7.0 Place of Performance**

The place of performance will be at Government and contractor facilities. Approximately fifty percent (50%) of the work will be performed at NSWC Crane; the remainder of the tasking will be performed at other Government and contractor facilities. Contractor personnel on-site at NSWC Crane and other Government facilities will be authorized access to Government owned equipment, including a personal computer/printer with appropriate software, use of telephone, desk, and lab space. Work to be performed at contractor facilities requires that the contractor provide all necessary facilities, office space, lab space, testing facilities, storage facilities, and required auxiliary equipment to accomplish tasking. For efforts performed at NSWC, Crane, contractor facilities shall be located within a 50 mile radius of NSWC Crane. For efforts performed in Washington DC, contractor facilities shall be located within a 10 mile radius of the Pentagon and SSP HQ (Washington Navy Yard). Other off-site Government Furnished Facility locations include Cape Canaveral, Florida; Groton, CT; and Barrow-in-Furness, United Kingdom. Contractor personnel at NSWC Crane may be required to periodically relocate as office areas are moved to conform to re-organizations within the Crane Division or continuous improvement process changes to improve efficiency.

## **CNIN-NOTICE-0003 CONTRACTOR MANPOWER REPORTING (NOV 2013)**

The contractor shall report contractor labor hours (including subcontractor labor hours) required for performance of services provided under this contract for the Naval Surface Warfare Center, Crane Division via a secure data collection site. (c) The restrictions on use and disclosure of the data and software described above also apply to such information received from the Government through any means to which the Contractor has access in the performance of this contract that contains proprietary or other restrictive markings.

(d) The Contractor agrees that it will promptly notify the Contracting Officer of any attempt by an individual, company, or Government representative not directly involved in the effort to be performed under this contract to gain access to such proprietary information. Such notification shall include the name and organization of the individual, company, or Government representative seeking access to such information.

(e) The Contractor shall include this requirement in subcontracts of any tier which involve access to information covered by paragraph (a), substituting "subcontractor" for "Contractor" where appropriate.

(f) Compliance with this requirement is a material requirement of this contract.

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**HQ C-2-0011 COMPUTER SOFTWARE AND/OR COMPUTER DATABASE(S)  
DELIVERED TO AND/OR RECEIVED FROM THE GOVERNMENT (NAVSEA) (APR  
2004)**

(a) The Contractor agrees to test for viruses all computer software and/or computer databases, as defined in the clause entitled "RIGHTS IN NONCOMMERCIAL COMPUTER SOFTWARE AND NONCOMMERCIAL COMPUTER SOFTWARE DOCUMENTATION" (DFARS 252.227-7014), before delivery of that computer software or computer database in whatever media and on whatever system the software is delivered. The Contractor warrants that any such computer software and/or computer database will be free of viruses when delivered.

(b) The Contractor agrees to test any computer software and/or computer database(s) received from the Government for viruses prior to use under this contract.

(c) Unless otherwise agreed in writing, any license agreement governing the use of any computer software to be delivered as a result of this contract must be paid-up and perpetual, or so nearly perpetual as to allow the use of the computer software or computer data base with the equipment for which it is obtained, or any replacement equipment, for so long as such equipment is used. Otherwise the computer software or computer database does not meet the minimum functional requirements of this contract. In the event that there is any routine to disable the computer software or computer database after the software is developed for or delivered to the Government, that routine shall not disable the computer software or computer database until at least twenty-five calendar years after the delivery date of the affected computer software or computer database to the Government.

(d) No copy protection devices or systems shall be used in any computer software or computer database delivered under this contract to restrict or limit the Government from making copies. This does not prohibit license agreements from specifying the maximum amount of copies that can be made.

(e) Delivery by the Contractor to the Government of certain technical data and other data is now frequently required in digital form rather than as hard copy. Such delivery may cause confusion between data rights and computer software rights. It is agreed that, to the extent that any such data is computer software by virtue of its delivery in digital form, the Government will be licensed to use that digital-form data with exactly the same rights and limitations as if the data had been delivered as hard copy.

**HQ C-2-0032 INFORMATION AND DATA FURNISHED BY THE GOVERNMENT - ALTERNATE II (NAVSEA) (SEP 2009)**

(a) NAVSEA Form 4340/2 or Schedule C, as applicable, Government Furnished Information, incorporates by listing or specific reference, all the data or information which the Government has provided or will provide to the Contractor except for

(1) The specifications set forth in Section C, and

(2) Government specifications, including drawings and other Government technical documentation which are referenced directly or indirectly in the specifications set forth in Section C and which are applicable to this contract as specifications, and which are generally available and provided to Contractors or prospective Contractors upon proper request, such as Federal or Military Specifications, and Standard Drawings, etc.

(b) Except for the specifications referred to in subparagraphs (a)(1) and (2) above, the Government will not be obligated to provide to the Contractor any specification, drawing, technical documentation or other publication which is not listed or specifically referenced in NAVSEA Form 4340/2 or Schedule C, as applicable, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the specifications, the publications listed or specifically referenced in NAVSEA Form 4340/2 or Schedule C, as applicable, the clause entitled "GOVERNMENT PROPERTY" (FAR 52.245-1) or "GOVERNMENT PROPERTY INSTALLATION OPERATION SERVICES" (FAR 52.245-2), as applicable, or any other term or condition of this contract.

(c)(1) The Contracting Officer may at any time by written order:

(i) delete, supersede, or revise, in whole or in part, data listed or specifically referenced in NAVSEA Form 4340/2 or Schedule C, as applicable; or

(ii) add items of data or information to NAVSEA Form 4340/2 or Schedule C, as applicable; or

(iii) establish or revise due dates for items of data or information in NAVSEA Form 4340/2 or Schedule C, as applicable.

(2) If any action taken by the Contracting Officer pursuant to subparagraph (c)(1) immediately above causes an increase or decrease in the costs of, or the time required for, performance of any part of the work under this contract, the contractor may be entitled to an equitable adjustment in the contract amount and delivery schedule in accordance with the procedures provided for in the "CHANGES" clause of this contract.

"Person" as used herein includes Corporations, Partnerships, Joint Ventures, and other business enterprises.

(b) The Contractor warrants that to the best of its knowledge and belief, and except as otherwise set forth in the contract, the Contractor does not have any organizational conflict of interest(s) as defined in paragraph (a).

(c) It is recognized that the effort to be performed by the Contractor under this contract may create a potential organizational conflict of interest on the instant contract or on a future acquisition. In order to avoid this potential conflict of interest, and at the same time to avoid prejudicing the best interest of the Government, the right of the

Contractor to participate in future procurement of equipment and/or services that are the subject of any work under this contract shall be limited as described below in accordance with the requirements of FAR 9.5.

(d) (1) The Contractor agrees that it shall not release, disclose, or use in any way that would permit or result in disclosure to any party outside the Government any information provided to the Contractor by the Government during or as a result of performance of this contract. Such information includes, but is not limited to, information submitted to the Government on a confidential basis by other persons. Further, the prohibition against release of

Government provided information extends to cover such information whether or not in its original form, e.g., where the information has been included in Contractor generated work or where it is discernible from materials incorporating or based upon such information. This prohibition shall not expire after a given period of time.

(2) The Contractor agrees that it shall not release, disclose, or use in any way that would permit or result in disclosure to any party outside the Government any information generated or derived during or as a result of performance of this contract. This prohibition shall expire after a period of three years after completion of performance of this contract.

(3) The prohibitions contained in subparagraphs (d)(1) and (d)(2) shall apply with equal force to any affiliate of the Contractor, any subcontractor, consultant, or employee of the Contractor, any joint venture involving the Contractor, any entity into or with which it may merge or affiliate, or any successor or assign of the Contractor. The terms of paragraph (f) of this Special Contract Requirement relating to notification shall apply to any release of information in contravention of this paragraph (d).

(e) The Contractor further agrees that, during the performance of this contract and for a period of three years after completion of performance of this contract, the Contractor, any affiliate of the Contractor, any subcontractor, consultant, or employee of the Contractor, any joint venture involving the Contractor, any entity into or with which it may subsequently merge or affiliate, or any other successor or assign of the Contractor, shall not furnish to the United States Government, either as a prime contractor or as a subcontractor, or as a consultant to a prime contractor or subcontractor, any system, component or services which is the subject of the work to be performed under this contract. This exclusion does not apply to any recompetition for those

**52.222-99 ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM WAGE FOR CONTRACTORS (DEVIATION 2014-O0017) (JUNE 2014)**

This clause implements Executive Order 13658, Establishing a Minimum Wage for Contractors, dated February 12, 2014, and OMB Policy Memorandum M-14-09, dated June 12, 2014.

(a) Each service employee, laborer, or mechanic employed in the United States (the 50 States and the District of Columbia) in the performance of this contract by the prime Contractor or any subcontractor, regardless of any contractual relationship which may be alleged to exist between the Contractor and service employee, laborer, or mechanic, shall be paid not less than the applicable minimum wage under Executive Order 13658. The minimum wage required to be paid to each service employee, laborer, or mechanic performing work on this contract between January 1, 2015, and December 31, 2015, shall be \$10.10 per hour.

(b) The Contractor shall adjust the minimum wage paid under this contract each time the Secretary of Labor's annual determination of the applicable minimum wage under section 2(a)(ii) of Executive Order 13658 results in a higher minimum wage. Adjustments to the Executive Order minimum wage under section 2(a)(ii) of Executive Order 13658 will be effective for all service employees, laborers, or mechanics subject to the Executive Order beginning January 1 of the following year. The Secretary of Labor will publish annual determinations in the Federal Register no later than 90 days before such new wage is to take effect. The Secretary will also publish the applicable minimum wage on [www.wdol.gov](http://www.wdol.gov) (or any successor website). The applicable published minimum wage is incorporated by reference into this contract.

(c) The Contracting Officer will adjust the contract price or contract unit price under this clause only for the increase in labor costs resulting from the annual inflation increases in the Executive Order 13658 minimum wage beginning on January 1, 2016. The Contracting Officer shall consider documentation as to the specific costs and workers impacted in determining the amount

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of the adjustment.

(d) The Contracting Officer will not adjust the contract price under this clause for any costs other than those identified in paragraph (c) of this clause, and will not provide price adjustments under this clause that result in duplicate price adjustments with the respective clause of this contract implementing the Service Contract Labor Standards statute (formerly known as the Service Contract Act) or the Wage Rate Requirements (Construction) statute (formerly known as the Davis Bacon Act).

(e) The Contractor shall include the substance of this clause, including this paragraph (e) in all subcontracts.

## **52.244-2 SUBCONTRACTS (OCT 2010)**

(a) *Definitions.* As used in this clause—

“Approved purchasing system” means a Contractor’s purchasing system that has been reviewed and approved in accordance with Part 44 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR)

“Subcontract” means any contract, as defined in FAR Subpart 2.1, entered into by a subcontractor to furnish supplies or services for performance of the prime contract or a subcontract. It includes, but is not limited to, purchase orders, and changes and modifications to purchase orders.

(b) When this clause is included in a fixed-price type contract, consent to subcontract is required only on unpriced contract actions (including unpriced modifications or unpriced delivery orders), and only if required in accordance with paragraph (c) or (d) of this clause.

(c) If the Contractor does not have an approved purchasing system, consent to subcontract is required for any subcontract that-

(1) Is of the cost-reimbursement, time-and-materials, or labor-hour type; or

(2) Is fixed-price and exceeds—

(i) For a contract awarded by the Department of Defense, the Coast Guard, or the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, the greater of the simplified acquisition threshold or 5 percent of the total estimated cost of the contract; or

(ii) For a contract awarded by a civilian agency other than the Coast Guard and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, either the simplified acquisition threshold or 5 percent of the total estimated cost of the contract.

(d) If the Contractor has an approved purchasing system, the Contractor nevertheless shall obtain the Contracting Officer’s written consent before placing the following subcontracts:

*Contracts with any firm not included with the basic contract proposal. For adding team members to the task order after award, the task order contracting officer’s approval is required. The task*

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order contracting officer will determine the documentation to be submitted by the contractor for approval.

(e)(1) The Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer reasonably in advance of placing any subcontract or modification thereof for which consent is required under paragraph (b), (c), or (d) of this clause, including the following information:

(i) A description of the supplies or services to be subcontracted.

(ii) Identification of the type of subcontract to be used.

(iii) Identification of the proposed subcontractor.

(iv) The proposed subcontract price.

(v) The subcontractor's current, complete, and accurate certified cost or pricing data and Certificate of Current Cost or Pricing Data, if required by other contract provisions.

(vi) The subcontractor's Disclosure Statement or Certificate relating to Cost Accounting Standards when such data are required by other provisions of this contract.

(vii) A negotiation memorandum reflecting –

(A) The principal elements of the subcontract price negotiations;

(B) The most significant considerations controlling establishment of initial or revised prices;

(C) The reason certified cost or pricing data were or were not required;

(D) The extent, if any, to which the Contractor did not rely on the subcontractor's certified cost or pricing data in determining the price objective and in negotiating the final price;

(E) The extent to which it was recognized in the negotiation that the subcontractor's certified cost or pricing data were not accurate, complete, or current; the action taken by the Contractor and the subcontractor; and the effect of any such defective data on the total price negotiated;

(F) The reasons for any significant difference between the Contractor's price objective and the price negotiated; and

(G) A complete explanation of the incentive fee or profit plan when incentives are used. The explanation shall identify each critical performance element, management decisions used to quantify each incentive element, reasons for the incentives, and a summary of all trade-off possibilities considered.

(2) The Contractor is not required to notify the Contracting Officer in advance of entering into any subcontract for which consent is not required under paragraph (b), (c), or (d) of this clause.

(f) Unless the consent or approval specifically provides otherwise, neither consent by the Contracting Officer to any subcontract nor approval of the Contractor's purchasing system shall constitute a determination –

(1) Of the acceptability of any subcontract terms or conditions;

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(2) Of the allowability of any cost under this contract; or

(3) To relieve the Contractor of any responsibility for performing this contract.

(g) No subcontract or modification thereof placed under this contract shall provide for payment on a cost-plus-a-percentage-of-cost basis, and any fee payable under cost-reimbursement type subcontracts shall not exceed the fee limitations in FAR 15.404-4(c)(4)(i).

(h) The Contractor shall give the Contracting Officer immediate written notice of any action or suit filed and prompt notice of any claim made against the Contractor by any subcontractor or vendor that, in the opinion of the Contractor, may result in litigation related in any way to this contract, with respect to which the Contractor may be entitled to reimbursement from the Government.

(i) The Government reserves the right to review the Contractor’s purchasing system as set forth in FAR Subpart 44.3.
